1 Strongest form

Major premise God cannot err.

Minor premise The Bible is God's word.

Conclusion Therefore, the Bible cannot err.

2 Strong form

Major premise As the word of God, the Bible cannot err.

Minor premise As the word of men, the writers were free to err, but did not.

Conclusion Therefore, the Bible is without err.

3 Weaker form (A)

Major premise The Bible is a human book.

Minor premise Human writings sometimes contain errors.

Conclusion Therefore, it is possible for the Bible to contain errors.

Weaker form (B)

Major premise The Bible is a human book.

Minor premise It is possible for human writers to write the truth without errors.

Conclusion Therefore, it is possible that the Bible was written without errors.

4 Weakest form

Major premise The Bible is a human book.

Minor premise Human writings always contain errors.

Conclusion Therefore, the Bible contains errors.
