

1 Strongest form

Major premise	<i>God cannot err.</i>
Minor premise	<i>The Bible is God's word.</i>
Conclusion	Therefore, the Bible cannot err.

2 Strong form

Major premise	<i>As the word of God, the Bible cannot err.</i>
Minor premise	<i>As the word of men, the writers were free to err, but did not.</i>
Conclusion	Therefore, the Bible is without err.

3 Weaker form (A)

Major premise	<i>The Bible is a human book.</i>
Minor premise	<i>Human writings sometimes contain errors.</i>
Conclusion	Therefore, it is possible for the Bible to contain errors.

Weaker form (B)

Major premise	<i>The Bible is a human book.</i>
Minor premise	<i>It is possible for human writers to write the truth without errors.</i>
Conclusion	Therefore, it is possible that the Bible was written without errors.

4 Weakest form

Major premise	<i>The Bible is a human book.</i>
Minor premise	<i>Human writings always contain errors.</i>
Conclusion	Therefore, the Bible contains errors.
