

Understanding Spiritual Authority

Spiritual leadership in the local church is a fact of life in the New Testament (compare Acts 14.23; Philippians 1.1; Titus 1.5; Hebrews 13.24; etc.). These persons are responsible for carrying out the will of God in their ministry as bondservants of Jesus Christ (Acts 20.28; Ephesians 4.11; Titus 1.7; Hebrews 13.17; First Peter 5.4; etc.). The terms *elder* (Acts 14.23; First Timothy 5.17; Titus 1.5; First Peter 5.1), *overseer* (Acts 20.28; Philippians 1.1; First Timothy 3.2; Titus 1.7), and *pastor* (Acts 20.28; Ephesians 4.11; First Peter 5.2) are used interchangeably in the New Testament to refer to those entrusted by God with the responsibility to lead His people. Look up these words in a good dictionary and give a brief explanation of what each term tells us about the nature of their leadership.
